Productive efforts like creative writings, researches, theses/dissertations, monographs, professional or technical publications, data papers and other similar works of the faculties of any academic institution have attracted enormous attention since the second half of this century. This increasing interest is born not simply out of curiosity, but more out of a growing awareness that this initiative is becoming a relevant and valuable part of the major contributions of the academe to national and regional development. Whether they are published or unpublished, these writings are highly significant resources not only of the university but also of the country as a whole. In every way, they serve as inputs and outputs of the university.

Cognizant of this, Mindanao State University through the University Research Center has provided incentives in this direction. Since the university has gained its foothold in socio-economic development, I would venture to say that these resources have remained untapped. This writer is strongly convinced that works of this nature should be disseminated through bibliographic means.

Aims and objectives/Scope and limitation

The major concern of this research is to provide a bibliographic listing of the works of the faculties of Mindanao State University. It intends to present a systematic listing of these works.

Representative of the various academic disciplines, the listing will attempt to include both **published** and **unpublished** works such as

books and other monographic publications, journal articles, newspaper/periodical/magazine articles, encyclopedic or series articles, collected works, data/professional/occasional papers, theses/dissertations/seminar papers/special problems/research papers, papers read at seminars, conferences, lectures, conferences, symposia, meetings; literary genres, and others. To a certain extent, it will also cover forthcoming publications, works-in-progress, and other manuscripts of research value.

While comprehensiveness is of paramount importance in every bibliography, this work is by no means complete. At best it could only serve as a preliminary survey. Faculty members who are on leave are not thoroughly covered. Serious attempts are being made to include them in a later work.

A word or two may enlighten the users of this bibliography on its coverage. The term faculty always denotes the teaching staff of the academe. The scope of the work have expanded to encompass the academic teaching and academic non-teaching staff: instructors, assistant professor, associate professor, full professor and university professors, the research personnel, the librarians, guidance counsellors, ... (University Code)

The listing does not intend to be evaluative of the productivity of the faculty or the institution. It simply presents in bibliographic style the works for possible dissemination and use of such materials to other colleagues.

Significance of the study

The rigorous process of research usually involve a review of related literature. For this, a researcher consults a bibliography or bibliographies. Given this list, this preliminary work will be an important tool in facilitating research.

National interest has been focused on the region. It will be worthwhile undertaking a bibliographic record of what has been done in the area. In a way, the listing ultimately aims to contribute to national and regional efforts of bibliographical organization and control.

It is a fact that a university archive has an important role to play in research. Making a listing to such a valuable project is an important and valuable step in this direction.

Review of related literature

The University of the Philippines has published its *Researches and Others of the Faculties of the University of the Philippines* through the University Coordinating Council (2). The work made a separate listing of published and unpublished works. Silliman University has also come up with "List of Research Publications and Other Articles of the Silliman University Faculty and Staff for the School Year" This appears in alphabetical order and in mimeographed form (3). Other universities and colleges have incorporated these works in their journals and other serial publications.

Methodology

Questionnaires and interviews have been extensively utilized to collect the titles. This was followed by actual checking of materials with their authors. Library resources have been consulted. Existing bibliographies have been double-checked.

As many of the materials are not readily available through regular channels (e.g. manuscripts available in the owners' hands), the collection of data involved personal visits to the authors.

Explanation in the use of the Bibliography

a. Arrangement. The listing is presented in a form of a series. The present list serves as Part I which solely lists the works of the faculties of the College of Arts and Sciences. Other disciplines (as represented by college and other academic units) will follow in the subsequent issues of the journal.

The listing is primarily arranged by academic units. Under each college or academic units, it presents the works of the faculty by department. Under each department, an alphabetical listing of the faculty follow. Under each faculty cited, a chronological sequence of their works is presented. In most cases, a brief annotation is made on works.

b. Sample entry:

Explanation: Under the Department of Philosophy, the works of Prof. Gripaldo are presented in chronological order. Along with name, his rank is also indicated.

c. Kate Turabian (4) has been used to provide consistency and uniformity of entries. To a certain extent, abbreviations and location symbols of some materials are indicated to facilitate location of these entries.

It is suggested that users consult the list of abbreviations and location symbols at the end of the introductory part of this article.

A list of periodicals cited is also provided for the reference of the users.

in case of subsidiary authors (co-authors, joint authors, co- or joint editors, translators, collectors, collaborators) are indicated in some entries.

For female faculty members whose works have been known under their maiden name, *see* and *see also* references are use to provide clarity. Example of which:
